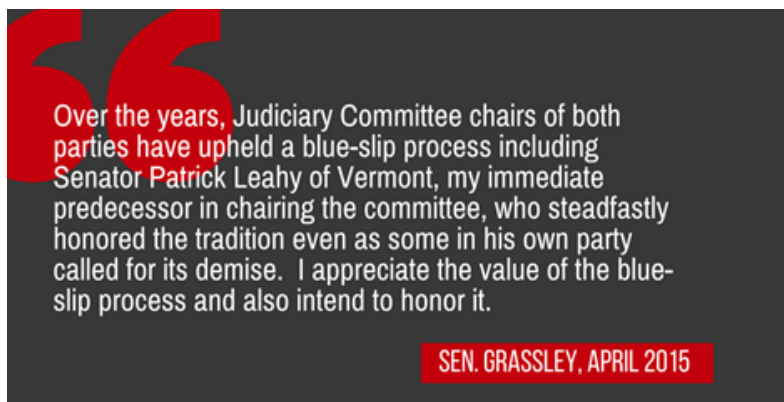


Call to Action

BLUESLIPS 101

- Longstanding tradition in the Senate Judiciary Committee
- Both home-state senators of a judicial nominee — even if not on the Committee — must turn in the blueslip for Committee to move forward with consideration
- Missing blueslip = nominee does not get hearing
- Single senator has veto power over president's court pick
- Ensures senators can use Constitutional "advice and consent" power and we get mainstream judges
- Threats to end the tradition must be stopped!
